Dear Parents & Guardians of Bike Riders & Walkers,

We wanted to touch base with you as the parent of a student who walks to and/or from school. Our most important concern when it comes to transportation is that your child arrives to and from school in a safe manner. As in previous years, we make every attempt to send the walkers if there is favorable weather and it is safe for students to walk home.

In order to communicate with our walking families, we would like to create a distribution phone list on Remind. This list will be utilized as soon as you sign-up. This means we will be able to send an automated text out to your family in the event inclement weather prevents us from safely dismissing your children as walkers. Parents will need to sign-up to be included on this list and receive messages. The directions for signing-up is located on the back of this letter and takes less than five minutes to complete. All walkers will be dismissed as car riders in the event it is unsafe for students to walk. Parents should enter the carline on Malcomb Drive to pick-up on rainy days and display the car tag on the rear view mirror. If you are walking to the school to pick your child up, you may come to the office with photo ID and check them out.

Thank you for your continued support in a smooth safe dismissal for your children. Please contact us if your circumstance prevents us from using the plan outlined above.
